### Harvest Donations

Another huge thank you to everyone who donated goods to our Harvest Assembly. The school council did a fantastic job in organising the event and the lady from Foodbank was thrilled with the goods we collected. We have had a note from Foodbank informing us that our goods weighed in at 107.8kg which is the equivalent to 247 meals which as Clare who came to visit school said 'is fab!'

### Lateness

We have noticed since September that late arrival to school is becoming an issue for some of our pupils. Can we politely remind parents that school registration is at 9.00 so children need to be in class at their tables for this time. Whilst we fully understand that there may be the odd occasion when a child is late i.e. traffic caused by an accident, this is completely unavoidable and a one off but unfortunately we have some pupils that are late several times a week. This results in them missing quite a chunk of their learning over a half term as learning starts in each class at 9.00 with either 5 a day or guided reading. Currently we have had 81 times where pupils have been late before registers close since September, this is an increase on this period last year when the figure was 61. However the good news is that children arriving after registers have closed is much improved and the figure has halved compared to this time last year so thank you for your support here and once again can I ask that this support continues to ensure that all children are in school to be registered at 9.00.
