Can I please politely ask parents to be mindful of the schools' neighbours when parking at pick up and drop off times. Recently we have had an increase in complaints as people have been parking over their driveways and so they are unable to get on or off when they need to. The neighbours like the school fully understand how difficult a road Longton Lane is for parking but are very frustrated when they have places to be and cannot get their cars off. We have also had a couple of complaints regarding foul language from our parents when they have been asked to move their cars, this has not only offended our neighbours but other parents as well.

Whilst we know it is a difficult situation can we just ask everyone to take a moment to check that you are not blocking other people.

We have had further complaints from parents that people are literally stopping in the middle of the road, often by the narrower part of the road near to the playground gate, to drop children off and this causes traffic to back up. Can people please think carefully where they stop.

Tom does a fantastic job as our lollipop person but he also has been verbally abused in the road by drivers, whilst this was not our parents it would appear that the drivers involved had been frustrated by the parking further along the road and had thought it fit to take out their anger on Tom.

All matters have been reported to the local highways department and neighbours have informed the police of registration numbers but I hope everyone can help with just a little thought, it would be appreciated by all.
